PreK 3 & 4	Cans of Potatoes
Kindergarten	Cans of cranberry sauce
First Grade	Cans of pie filling, 16 oz.
Second Grade	Pie Crusts
Third Grade	Cans of gravy
Fourth Grade	Bags or boxes of stuffing
Fifth Grade	Boxes of Macaroni & Cheese
Sixth Grade	Boxes of Macaroni & Cheese
Seventh Grade	Cans of canned yams
Eighth Grade	Canned vegetables such as: mixed vegetables, corn, green beans, sweet peas, carrots.
