SPECIAL PERSON LUNCHEON

Q. What is the Special Person Luncheon?

A. This is an opportunity to honor a special person (grandparent, aunt or uncle, godparent, etc...) in your child's life by having them share their lunch and their school with them. The students in Grades PreK3-8 may invite "a" special person to St. Stephen School that day.

Q. Does the special person *need* to bring a lunch?

A. No, for your convenience, the PTO will be selling delicious hoagies for you to purchase for your child and their special person. This **order form** will be in the brown envelope as well as on the PTO page. Students may also choose to bring their lunch with them that day.

Q. What time should the special person arrive?

A. We ask the special person to please arrive 5-10 minutes before the students come down for their designated lunch.

1) Students in K-8 with last names beginning A-L will have from 11:30am until 12:15 pm to eat with their "special person", take them to visit their classroom or the Book Fair. Students will then return to their classroom by 12:15pm.

2) Students in K-8 with last names M-Z will have from 12:15-1:00pm to eat with their "special person", show them their classroom or visit the Book Fair. Students will then return to their classroom by 1:00pm.

3) All PreK 3 & 4 students will eat from 11:30am-12:15pm with their entire class in the cafeteria along with their special "person". They may also take them back to visit their classroom or the Book Fair.

Q. What if my child does not have a special person coming that day?

A. Please let your child's teacher know if this is the case so they may make arrangements for them during the lunch period.

Reminder: After lunch the students are expected to complete the school day, remaining in school until 2:30pm dismissal and not leaving early with their "special person".
